I represent Fall River Electric Cooperative a non-profit electric utility. We are BPA customers and due to the termination of the Southeast Idaho exchange agreement by PAC, we are in desperate need of transmission to have access to BPA power. We serve 16,000 meters in Idaho, Montana, and Wyoming. This transmission Corridor is essential to bring renewable hydro energy to Idaho. If we don't ~~build~~ build this link our energy needs will likely be provided using Carbon based generation.

BPA has evaluated multiple alternatives and this Boardman to Hemingway is the least cost option.
