My name is Marilyn Logsdon a family member of Lazy S Over 7 Inc. Our ranch is affected by the Boardman to Hemmingway Transmission Line. The ranch is affected by Timber Canyon Alternate. All of the routes come together and will affect me as a landowner. Reference maps number 33 & 34.

The National Historic Oregon Trail (3.2.9 trails) crosses my property several times spanning many miles. The building of this project would degrade this historic trail by the construction with heavy equipment operations it would take to complete.

The wildlife (3.2.4) activity and habitat of upland birds, sage grouse, deer, elk, and bear would negatively interrupt their natural environment. This area is an active wintering and breeding ground for these species.

I have a serious concern that these routes have not been investigated thoroughly enough to show purpose and need for this project. There is not enough rock hard data to determine this proposed action which would affect my livelihood.

As a senior citizen it would be an injustice of my economic future and the future of my family being able to continue ranching as a livelihood.

I do not support the 500kv line or the rebuild 138/69kv on the property.
